

**RECIPROCITY AGREEMENT**  
**between**  
**THE AUSTRALIAN INSTITUTE OF QUANTITY SURVEYORS**  
**AND**  
**THE CANADIAN INSTITUTE OF QUANTITY SURVEYORS**

Whereas the Australian Institute of Quantity Surveyors (AIQS) and the Canadian Institute of Quantity Surveyors (CIQS) see benefits to members of both professional bodies in establishing a Reciprocity Agreement, the AIQS and the CIQS agree to the following:

1. A corporate member (Associate or Fellow) of the AIQS in good standing, may be elected as a Professional Quantity Surveyor (PQS) member of the CIQS subject to:
  - a. Completion of only the By-Laws, Rules, Regulations and Ethics portion of the CIQS Test of Professional Experience Practice Problem.
  - b. One year's practical work experience as a quantity surveyor in Canada, in circumstances which will enable a corporate member of the CIQS to confirm the professional activities undertaken.
  - c. Subsequent election to any other grade or qualification of the CIQS will be in accordance with the appropriate CIQS By-Laws and Regulations.
2. A member (Professional Quantity Surveyor) of the CIQS in good standing, may be elected as an Associate (AAIQS) member of the AIQS subject to:
  - a. A professional interview conducted by corporate members of the AIQS to confirm the applicant's knowledge of law and practice in Australia.
  - b. One year's practical work experience as a quantity surveyor in Australia, in circumstances which will enable a corporate member of the AIQS to confirm the professional activities undertaken.
  - c. Subsequent election to any other grade or qualification of the AIQS will be in accordance with the appropriate AIQS By-Laws and Regulations.
3. This agreement does not apply to any member of the AIQS or CIQS that has been elected to membership of either body through a reciprocity agreement with the other professional body.
4. Each professional body will notify the other of any merger or major constitutional or educational changes.
5. The AIQS and CIQS agree to exchange professional research and knowledge and to co-operate in any topics of mutual interest or liaise on matters of mutual concern.

# LETTER OF AGREEMENT

BETWEEN

THE CANADIAN INSTITUTE OF QUANTITY SURVEYORS (CIQS)

AND

THE AUSTRALIAN INSTITUTE OF QUANTITY SURVEYORS (AIQS)

Following the signing of the Reciprocity Agreement between the CIQS and AIQS, it is hereby also agreed that the two organizations will:

1. Exchange professional development resources
2. Exchange research reports
3. Liaise on educational developments
4. Liaise on development of standards and competencies.

The AIQS additionally agrees to provide the CIQS with copies of its manuals, technical texts, guidelines and practice notes. The AIQS will authorize the sale by the CIQS of any such resources and the republication or rebadging of such publications by the CIQS in accordance with a mutually beneficial financial arrangement which will be agreed upon from time to time by both organizations.

Similarly, the CIQS agrees to provide the AIQS with its publications under the same conditions as stated above.
